Important Information

As of midnight Sunday August 2nd wearing a face mask when out in public will be mandatory in Victoria.

What does this mean for kinder?

- Parents/Care givers will be expected to be wearing masks when dropping off/collecting their child from kinder (unless they have a medical condition that exempts them– if this is the case we ask that you respect the social distancing rules by staying 1.5 metres from our staff and other families)
- Educators at this time are not required to wear a mask whilst teaching but at their discretion will be permitted to wear one if they are the staff member at the gate for drop off/pick up time.
- Victoria's health and human services department says it is not recommending children under the age of 12 wear face masks, although "individual families can make their own decisions".
