SING AND GROW PROGRAM

Alexandra & District Kindergarten's School Readiness Funding plan includes the Sing and Grow Program. Throughout Term 3, all of the children (3 and 4 yr old groups) will participate in these sessions. Music therapy is a research-based allied health profession in which music is used to actively support people to improve their health, functioning, and wellbeing. It can help people of all ages to manage their physical and mental health and enhance their quality of life. You don't need to be musical to take part in or benefit from music therapy. Qualified registered music therapists plan and provide musical experiences for our children within the kindergarten setting. Each session is tailored to the needs and goals of the children. 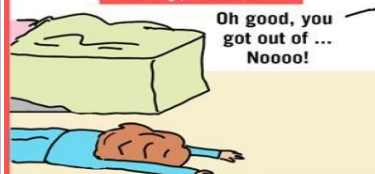
